Mission Statement

It is the mission of this Parish Council to represent the aspirations, needs and concerns of its parishioners and to debate and determine (democratically, publically and transparently) the majority opinion of the community and convey that result to all who might wish to affect our community.

The Parish Council Objectives are:-

- To ensure that the community receives the efficient and cost effective services requested by its parishioners.
- To maintain strict budgetary controls to ensure that the precept is spent wisely.
- To provide adequate insurance cover.
- To provide and maintain adequate street lighting.
- To work closely with the planning authorities to monitor potential development and to inform and involve parishioners in this process.
- To endeavour to obtain funds /grants from outside bodies for the benefit of the community.
- To regularly report on the condition and/or operation of the infrastructure of the parish and its basic services e.g. roads, water, sewage, rubbish and recycling services.
- To comply with the legal obligations of others within the parish e.g. footpath and bridleway regulations.
- To liaise with other bodies that might have an impact on the parish e.g. the police and other emergency services, the Parochial Church Council, the Village Hall Committee, St. Lucia's C of E Primary School, the Canal Restoration Society, local landowners and RAF Shawbury.
- To proactively canvass local opinion and convey that opinion to all who might seek to influence the future of the community.
- To proactively canvass opinion as to the performance of the Parish Council.
