19/025. Present.

19/029. April Meeting Date.

19/030. Monthly Report from Councillor Picton.

Councillor Picton was unable to attend the meeting due to illness. However, she sent the following information via email:

- Shropshire Council has introduced a new, improved problem reporting system and we are urged to use it. **ACTION**: Parish Clerk to register.
- There are several Parish Councils who are looking at purchasing Vehicle Activated Signs. It was agreed that, as the Parish Council is not considering installing signs in the village, this should not be pursued.

19/031. Accounts.

It was proposed, seconded and resolved that the following amount be approved for payment:

19/032. Place Plan Review.

19/033. Community Infrastructure Levy.

It was agreed that Shropshire Council's changes to the application process for Community Infrastructure Levy raised by development in the village (de Quincey Fields) to be spent in the village, prevent an application that is likely to succeed.

- 19/00148/FUL. Demolition of existing cottages and replacement with 2 new dwellings. Decision pending.
- 16/04965/EIA. Poultry units at the Rea. New Landscape and Visual Impact Report on Shropshire Council's planning register. Mr. Jordan advised that he is to meet with the Canal Trust. Decision still pending.

- Haughton Crossroads: No news on this. ACTION: a) Parish Clerk to ask the Forestry Commission

- Diversion of Footpath 22: Shropshire Council has advised the Parish Council that they are
 proposing to divert the footpath that appears to run through the gardens of nos. 9 and 10
 Pelham Road. It was proposed, seconded and resolved that the Parish Council does not object
 to the proposal. ACTION: Parish Clerk to advise Shropshire Council of this.
- The Parish Clerk reported that she has created and launched the new Parish Council website (www.uptonmagna.com). She was thanked for her work in achieving this.
