We have been asking Shropshire council to resurface the road on Haughmond hill for some time and with Councillor Picton's support it has been done and there are ongoing negotiations to get yellow lines painted as there is still some inconsiderate parking.

A small job that has made a big difference is the installation of a drop kerb outside the school to allow wheel chair access this one was done with an email request from a Parish Councillor to Shropshire council who thought there was one !

This year a "community litter pick" was organised and it was well attended, our thanks go to the organiser and participants, a job well done and it has "made a difference".

During our summer break our Clerk resigned and Karen Smith Wells took on the role until we appointed Mrs Jeniffer Turner and we welcome her to the Council.

We have not raised the precept for many years, but unfortunately due to circumstances out of our control we have had to raise the Parish council precept, it's a decision we do not take lightly!

This next year is going to be very challenging as we are going to have to make some difficult financial choices two of which are the ongoing Street light maintenance and the Defib both of which are community assets, but come at a cost, we shall do all we can to find a way to retain these for all.
